Vehicles Ahead and/or Behind

onto the road

If the Pedestrian comes/is

1st Mark 1. Identify Moving Hazards → What are Hazards → Motor vehicles Keep Your **Pedestrians Commentary Super Bicycles** Animals / "Dogs Mainly" Simple Where from → Left Right Ahead (In front of you) Behind (Check mirror) Oncoming (Towards you) What are you doing about the Hazard \rightarrow \rightarrow $\downarrow \downarrow \downarrow$ $\downarrow \downarrow \downarrow$ Sample Commentary Phrases On detecting \downarrow Respond by saying \downarrow **Oncoming Vehicles** \rightarrow 'Oncoming vehicles, keeping left" "Giving Way" "Looking for a gap"

"Vehicles ahead" "I'm slowing down"

or "Slowing down" "Steering right or left"

Say "Watching" or "Checking"

"Vehicles behind" "Checking" or there are no vehicles behind.

"Vehicles ahead and/or behind, checking following distance"

Say "Its all clear and continuing, Checking, still clear, continuing"

"Its all clear and continuing" or "Heres a gap, continuing" "Vehicles from left and/or right, Giving Way" "Looking for a gap" Vehicles from left and/or Right \rightarrow "Its all clear and continuing" or "Heres a gap, continuing"
