Sample Commentary Phrases

On detecting ↓

Respond by saying ↓

Oncoming Vehicles	→	"Oncoming vehicles, keeping left" "Giving Way" "Looking for a gap"
		"Its all clear and continuing" or "Heres a gap, continuing"
Vehicles from left and/or Right	→	"Vehicles from left and/or right, Giving Way" "Looking for a gap"
		"Its all clear and continuing" or "Heres a gap, continuing"
On approach to Intersection Vehicles Ahead	→	"Vehicles ahead" "I'm slowing down"
On approach to Intersection Vehicles Behind	→	"Vehicles behind" "Checking" or there are no vehicles behind.
Vehicles Ahead and/or Behind	→	"Vehicles ahead and/or behind, checking following distance"
"Pedestrians" →	"On Left" →	Say "Watching" or "Checking"
If the Pedestrian comes/is	or "Right" →	
onto the road →	or "Ahead" →	
		or "Slowing down" "Steering right or left"
If No Hazards at all, DO NOT say nothing	→	Say "Its all clear and continuing, Checking, still clear, continuing"
